Our elementary and middle schools will continue to administer the NWEA Map Growth Assessments in reading and mathematics for our grades 1 through 8 students. Our plan is to assess students during the fall, winter, and spring time periods (see below).

Each time we complete the reading and mathematics assessments with your children, your building principals will share the results with you. The results shared will include **achievement results** (RIT score your child earned in reading and mathematics during the present time period) and **growth results** (the growth your child experienced in reading and mathematics over time).

Our teachers will analyze their classes' reading and mathematics results with their building principals along with our district supervisors in order to make the appropriate adjustments to your child's instruction.
