## 9. Committee Reports

#### Education

Mrs. Ferrera provided an update on the life skills program that Mrs. Symmons presented at the last meeting. We're also finalizing on space for the life skills program at VHS. The extended school year program invitations were sent to families and we're in the process of finalizing a reading intervention program for the summer. Curriculum Council will move to in-person on Wednesday, April 19th. NJ Start Strong is now being phased out. NJGPA field test were completed and the actual test will be administered next school year. PD on pedagogy is scheduled for our elementary school. Strategic planning is ongoing and the next meeting is on April 27th at 7 pm in the Learning Commons.

#### Finance

o Mrs. Ferrera provided an update on residency verification and collaborating with Verona PD on residency investigations. Brown & Brown, our health insurance broker confirmed a 8.96% increase for 2023-24 and will present it to the committee next month.

Mrs. Verzella asked about the outcome of the residency verification.

Mr. Wacha asked about the possibility to provide an incentive to recruit new candidates by offering discounted or free non-resident tuition.

Mrs. DiGiuseppe shared the hiring process and the practices to vet candidates before making a hiring recommendation.

Mrs. Freschi provided information regarding firearm safety in homes. Because safety and security is a component of our school district, we want to ensure that firearm safety is being practiced by all residents with firearms at home.

Mr. Wacha raised concern that the sample resolution refers to the Superintendent to educate the public, but we shouldn't use this resolution because the Superintendent is not a gun safety expert.

Mrs. Verzella agreed with Mr. Wacha and suggested drafting a resolution that would capture the notification, a notice that is intended with gun safety.

Mrs. Ferrera echoed the comments of the prior two board members and added that a collaboration with the Verona Police Department is needed to roll out a curriculum in our schools.

Ms. Sahadow shared that posting it in multiple locations would be overkill. One district-wide notification and instruction would be good.
